STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

Updated: July 14, 2015

Carver 20 Ton Hydraulic Press

This machine can only be operated by a trained and authorized personnel. Equipment must NOT be altered or modified without authorization. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Check the operation and condition of equipment before use.
- 2. Check for hydraulic fluid leaks report to PI.
- 3. Ensure column pins are fully engaged after adjusting height.
- 4. Carefully align work under press for even force to be applied.
- 5. Do NOT apply excessive force.
- 6. Do not exceed the maximum pressure indicated on the hydraulic press.
- 7. Keep hands/fingers away from all clamping and moving parts.
- 8. Use shoulder muscles when operating NOT lower back.
- 9. Use transparent plastic shield to cover the working area.
- 10. Clean the machine down and return any tools to storage areas after use.
- 12. Place all scrap or waste in the appropriate bin.
- 13. Report all machine faults and hazards to the PI.

CAUTION – Beware of high forces applied; applying uneven force to work; and flying or shattering objects. Use appropriate PPE.
